

Accessing eBook Resources

Here will find out how to access some eBook resources that we recommend using during your reading session.

Your Local Library

We're asking all volunteers to sign up to access your local library's eBook provision before your first session. You can find your local library [here](#), with information on how to sign up – many now offer the option to sign up online.

Subscription Services and Other Volunteer Accounts

Most of the resources we use require you to log in before you can read books. The login details are listed below. **Please remember these accounts are only for volunteers to use as resources for Doorstep Library sessions and are NOT to be shared with families. It is also helpful to save all of these websites as bookmarks on your internet browser so you can access them regularly.**
